The application is open for you who will participate at the annual meeting!

For 2021 we focus on the language of our hands and what they might communicate. How far can the discussion go when there is no spoken language present? Can our hands talk and if so, what do they say? In the applications we will look for how you as an artist interpret the concept 'Talking Hands' in your work. As artists we all work with our hands in one way or another, this time we want to take the discussion further than how the hands function as technical tools and aid. How do you reflect on your own or others' hands in relation to your own practice, their significance, their value and qualities? At a time when 'handmade' is on the rise again, one can wonder what is *not* handmade?

Read this before you apply:

- The application is open only to members of NTA
- The exhibition is a part of the Nordic Textile Meeting in Borås 2021 Talking Hands, where you as an applying artist is expected to participate in the annual meeting and bring your work with you back home after the exhibition has closed.
- The applying exhibitor agree to show the work at the entrance of Textile Fashion Centers during the period 13 Feb 7 March 2021. No compensation or fee is paid.
- There are few walls in the exhibition space, therefor we want you to read the specific information about hanging possibilities (see below)
- The exhibitor is aware that the work will be exhibited in an open space and will not be covered by insurance.
- The Textile Museum will notify the exhibitor via the specified e-mail when the work has arrived at the museum.
- The Textile Museum and NTA are responsible for hanging the work according to the exhibitor's instructions and according to the premises' conditions.
- The Textile Museum stores packing material that the work has been sent in that can be accessed again when the exhibition is closed.
- The exhibitor is responsible for the transport as well as any costs related to that to and from the Textile Museum.
- If the exhibitor in the event of Corona-related reasons is unable to attend the annual meeting as planned, NTA will offer to return the artwork. In all other cases, the applying artists are expected to participate in the annual meeting as well as deinstall the work on the last day.
- Artists who apply from Norway or Iceland (outside of EU) should send their work to Elisabeth Bremmer Remberg (see adress below) at the latest 1 Feb 2021, who will then bring the work to the exhibition. This is to avoid any artworks getting stuck in customs.
- Other countries/participants who do not deliver their work directly to the Textile Museum themselves must send their works to Malena Karlsson (see adress below) between 29 Jan and 1 Feb.
