Nordic cooperation and Nordic textile art form the basis of Nordic Textile Art. Annual meetings are therefore organized in circulation in the Nordic countries with thematic program content with joint activities to create a mobility with new forums for textile art. The association is open to anyone interested in Nordic textile art. Nordic Textile Art has members from all over the Nordics and other countries with an international interest in the textile art scene in the Nordics.

Nordic Textile Art is an independent non-profit association. The purpose of the association is to be a forum for making contacts and contribute to establishing new networks and meeting places for Nordic textile art. We want to enable physical as well as virtual meetings and create networks for the Nordic textile art. Long- term goals

NTA is a forum and meeting place for the Nordic textile artists.

NTA stimulates and facilitates information exchange.

NTA shows textile art on the national and Nordic art scene. NTA is a source of information for the Nordic textile art.

NTA has a broad cooperation and networking with artists and writers, cultural organizations both local, regional and global.

NTA has a Nordic affinity that provides anchoring both in the national and international arena.

What do we want to do now?

Nordic Textile Art is a network that wants to grow. NTA wants to create a forum for a dialogue concerning textile art. NTA wants to associate with already existing networks in the Nordic countries. We want to create forums and meeting points for Nordic textile artists and focus on textile art.

We address the association's affiliated artists and culture-interested members. We also address all branches of the network in the Nordics and the rest of the world with practicing artists and to everyone who wants to keep up with the textile-based art of today.

Goal for 2025 and 2026

The 2025 Nordic Textile Meeting will be held in Denmark on 10 - 13 April and will be held in Silkeborg with lectures, workshops, exhibitions and study visits. The theme is Exploring Fiber Heritage.

The annual meeting in 2026 with a textile conference and a program is planned. It is Sweden's turn to arrange. Preliminary plans are for the Nordic Textile Meeting to be a trip at sea with stops in Stockholm – Helsinki – Tallinn.

Networking - a development work to make it easier for NTA members to make contacts and create networks for Nordic textile art.

NTA a Nordic association with a Nordic board. For the sustainability of the association and the durability of the networks, it is important that the board meets. Digital meetings are good, but physical meetings are required to create better connections and new developing ideas. One important form of this is Textile Talk/Talk Textile, a joint workshop where through artistic practice we create an extended dialogue and new contact surfaces. The board's mission is to promote the members' sense of belonging. For the board's meetings on site, external funding is sought.

The Textile Museum of Sweden wants to act as a Nordic base for NTA. The Textile Museum wants to be an important arena for textile both national and international. Nordic Textile Art will during 2025 and 2026 deepen and strengthen its contact with the Textile Museum of Sweden in Borås.

NTA and ETN. Nordic Textile Art is a member of the European Textile Network. The NTA board is striving to strengthen the bonds with ETN. Since 2020, ETN have its office for the association in Haslach, Textile Zentrum, in Austria. Elisabeth Brenner Remberg is a member of the ETN board. This creates a good foundation for networking and contacts to be created between Nordic artists and the rest of the world.

Strong network structure. NTA will 2025 and 2026 strengthen and create bonds with TEXO and Uute i Finland, Dansk Tekstillaug – væv, tryk og broderi, the Textile Museum of Sweden, FAS-Fibre Art Sweden, Svenska Textilkonstnärer, KKV-Textiltryck Malmö, In Iceland; Textílfélagid and Textílsetur Íslands in Blöndus, Norske tekstilkunstnere and Norske kunsthåndverkere and Estonian Textile Association and Lithuanian textile artists.
